During 2022, six (6) internal affairs complaints were lodged by citizens against members of the department. The disposition categories are:

| 4. Unfounded- | The alleged incident did not occur. |

Closed- | In some case, the complaint or investigation is closed prior to reaching a disposition. Examples include situations when a complainant voluntarily requests that a complaint be withdrawn, or the subject officer terminates his or her employment prior to the disposition of the complaint. |

During 2022, five (5) investigations were conducted which stemmed from internal complaints filed within the organization. These internal complaints usually originate from a supervisor detecting officer performance deficiencies, a policy violation or an investigation of a motor vehicle crash involving an officer while on duty driving a department vehicle.
