

The 2017 operating budget increased by \$7,730 or 1.3%which is mostly due to the increase in the contract with Beverly to provide fire protections services for Edgewater Park Township.

The Tax Levy increased by \$7,938 resulting in a minimal increase in the tax rate equal to \$.001
