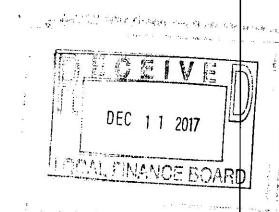

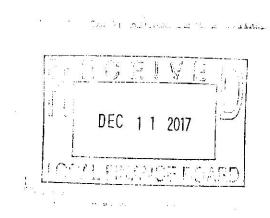

Because line items are relatively small, even minor fluctuations result in variances of +/-10%. Office expense increased \$887 (42%) and Professional Services increased \$2,000 (10%) due to inflation. Operations & Maintenance personnel decreased \$4,000 (12.2%) due to service performed by volunteers. Operations Miscellaneous expense increased \$1,720 (13.8%) due to increased costs to maintain aging equipment.

The Tax Levy increased \$8,120 (2%) due to no fund balance utilized, with no increase in the tax rate.
