The overall 2020 proposed budget increased by \$19,078 (4.1%) over the 2019 Budget, this increase is attributed to the following changes in the 2020 proposed budget (Note: because line items are relatively small, even minor fluctuations result in variances of +/-10%):

- 1. Administration Other Elections increased by \$300 (20.00%) based on prior years' actual expenditures.
- 2. Administration Other Office Expense increase by \$508 (14.3%) based on prior years' actual expenditures.
- 3. Cost of Operations and Maintenance Other Miscellaneous expenses increased by \$1,600 (10.4%) based on prior years' actual expenditures.
- 4. Appropriations offset with Revenue Fringe benefits increased by \$800 (33.3%) based on prior years' actual expenditures.
- 5. Appropriations offset with Revenue Other Telephone increased by \$280 (25.0%) based on prior years' actual expenditures.
- Appropriations offset with Revenue Other Vehicle Insurance and Expenses increased by \$700 (50.0%) to cover the increase in insurance premiums.
- 7. Appropriations offset with Revenue Other Miscellaneous expenses increased by \$6,330 (151.8%) based on increase of office supplies, postage and training.
- 2. The Tax Levy increased \$8,448 (2%) due to \$11,000 of unrestricted fund balance utilized. The tax rate increased \$.002.

THIRD EXTENSION OF INTER-LOCAL AGREEMENT FOR FIRE SERVICES (JANUARY 1, 2016 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2020) BETWEEN THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS, FIRE DISTRICT NO. 1, CITY BEVERLY AND THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS, FIRE DISTRICT NO. 1, TOWNSHIP OF EDGEWATER PARK.

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this 21 day of December 2015 between the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District No. 1, City of Beverly, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, hereinafter referred to as "Beverly" with its principal office located at 446 Broad Street, Beverly, New Jersey and the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District, No. 1, Township of Edgewater Park, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, hereinafter referred to as "Edgewater Park", with its principal office located at 400 Delanco Road, Edgewater Park, New Jersey. Collectively "Beverly" and "Edgewater Park" shall be known as the "Parties".

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A: 65-1 et seq., hereinafter referred to as the "Act" authorizes local units as defined in said "Act" to enter into joint agreements for the provision of governmental services which the parties thereto are empowered to provide or receive within their respective jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and purpose of the "Act" to encourage economy and regionalization of services as well as Shared Services Agreements to eliminate unnecessary duplication of efforts and costs; and

WHEREAS, both "Beverly" and "Edgewater Park" are local units under the "Act" and are both empowered to provide fire services within their respective jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, "Beverly" has qualified firefighting and other personnel under its control and supervision capable of providing fire services; and

WHEREAS, "Edgewater Park" desires to enter into an extension of an Inter-Local Agreement, as Extended, for the provision of fire services by "Beverly"; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have entered into three(3) Inter-Local Agreements each for a duration of seven (7) years with the most recent Agreement extended twice (2010-2012 and 2013-2015); and

WHEREAS, the Parties separately have agreed to continue the shared service for fire services; and

WHEREAS, both "Beverly" and "Edgewater Park" having found that the continuation of the shared services as set forth herein is in the best interest of their respective Districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and commissions hereinafter set forth pursuant to the authority provided by law, "Beverly" and "Edgewater Park" mutually agree as follows:

FIRST: "Beverly" shall continue to provide fire services to "Edgewater Park" for a term of five (5) years commencing January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2020.

SECOND: "Edgewater Park" shall pay the following consideration to "Beverly" for this service:

2016 .5% increase \$279,917.00 2017 .5% increase \$281,317.00

2018	1% increase	\$284,130.00
2019	1% increase	\$286,972.00
2020	1% increase	\$289,842.00

THIRD: Beverly Fire Co #I and Hope Hose Fire Co #2 shall each submit financial statements for the preceding year compiled by an independent accountant or certified public accountant in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principals (GAAP) to the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District No. 1, Township of Edgewater Park on an annual basis, during the term hereof, on or before June 1st.

THIRD: This Shared Service Agreement shall be known as the Third Extension to the Inter-Local Agreement for Fire Services (2016-2020).

FOURTH: All terms and conditions, not modified or changed herein, contained in the Inter-Local Agreement for Fire Service and First and Second Extensions shall continue and remain in full force and effect.

FIFTH: This Agreement shall take effect upon the adoption of appropriate resolutions by both parties hereto, and execution of this Agreement by authorized officers of the respective party.

This Agreement and referenced documents contain the entire understanding of the Parties and that no modifications or alternations hereto shall be effective unless in writing and signed with the same formality as this Agreement and pursuant to the appropriate resolution of the governmental entities.
