

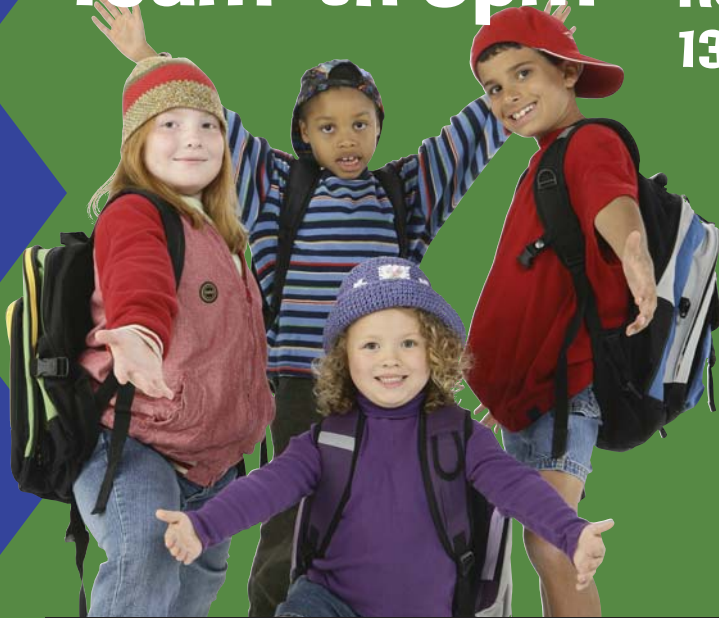
SCOUT OPEN HOUSE!

FREE TO BURLINGTON COUNTY RESIDENTS *No businesses, please – Identification required*

Bring all you confidential documents, i.e. bank statements, tax forms etc. for on-site destruction. All types of paper are okay and standard size staples or paper clips. Please no large binders or junk mail. To ensure that all residents can take advantage of this event we ask that the volume per resident not exceed 4 bags (ex. kitchen trash bags) or 4 boxes (ex. copier paper boxes) per household. Residents can bring old computer equipment (limit 6 units) and televisions (one TV per resident, 30" or less, no consoles) to be recycled.
